## Celebrators Trip Policy Forest Hills Baptist Church

(Effective 1/15/19)

The following guidelines have been established and approved by the Celebrators Council.

#### **Reservations:**

To reserve your spot on any trip, you will need to pay the full amount or a deposit. No spot will be reserved until funds are received by the church office.

To reserve your seat on a trip costing \$100 or under, you will need to pay the full amount for the trip. Trip reservation deadlines will be established according to each trip. We may be unable to place you on the trip after the deadline.

To reserve your seat on a trip costing over \$100, you will need to pay a deposit by the established date and then by a payment schedule established for each trip. Trip reservation deadlines will be established for each trip. We may be unable to place you on the trip after the deadline.

#### **Refunds:**

Trip refunds are allowed up to the established deadline. After the trip deadline, no refunds will be issued unless you find a person(s) to take your spot(s) on the trip. We will issue a refund on trips \$100 or under if you experience an extreme medical emergency or death to an immediate family member. We encourage you to consider trip insurance for trips over \$100.

If you cancel your reservation before or after the established trip deadline, you may still be responsible for a balance related to the trip. (example – cost for the single hotel room .vs. double occupancy)

#### **Trip Insurance:**

We would encourage each person to consider buying travel insurance, especially for trips over \$100. Below are only some suggested companies who offer travel insurance (not our endorsement). This is at your discretion. We also suggest that you check with your insurance carrier.
