With Appreciation



Now Available

Those who use public libraries probably enjoy library APPS and online-access catalogs. Our Enrichment Center now has those tools, too.

- Online Public Access Catalog: Just like the public library, you can search our catalog, see what's new, and get the details about our Topics of the Months and future events. When you set up an account, you can save items in a book bag for future use. You can also renew items that you want to keep for another four weeks as well as reserve items that will be ready for you the next time you drop by the Enrichment Center.
- Atriuum on the Go: Search for this free app in the APP Store. Email Enrichment.Center@fhbc.org for the connection information. With this app, you can search our catalog while standing in line at the store or a waiting room. Plus, you can scan the ISBN of a book or DVD at a store to see if we have that item. Atriuum on the Go also has a book bag and a book list for you to save items. Access to our catalog is available through this app.

FHBC is Now Fine Free

The Enrichment Center is a fine-free zone, especially for those items you meant to return but only recently found. You are welcome to return late items without the hassle of fines. Drop off your items through the glass slot in our drop box off the hallway or at the check-in sign just inside the Enrichment Center.

Self-Checkout

During Sunday School, you are welcome to check out items yourself.

- Find the Self-Checkout Sign on the counter as you enter the Enrichment Center.
- Fill out the form with your name and the item information—barcode number and title.
- If you have never checked out an item, fill out the form on the back of the Self-Checkout form. Leave the completed checkout form in the basket. We will set up an account for you. You will receive an email the next day to confirm your checked-out item with its due date.
